

Need an invitation letter for your visa as an author or attendee? Follow these step-bystep instructions!

- 1. Sign into this site using your SPIE credentials (username and password): <u>https://spie.smapply.io/sso/oauth/</u>
- After you are signed in, click on this link to go directly to the SPIE invitation letter request form page: <u>https://spie.smapply.io/prog/invitation_letter_request_form_for_spie_meetings/</u>
- 3. Click on the "Apply" button to begin the invitation letter request form.
 - Complete one form per person (requests for accompanying family members can be included in the same application)
 - Your name must be listed exactly as it appears on your passport. Any differences could lead to delay or denial of your visa
 - Requests are processed based on the order received, and the date of the conference
 - Expect up to three weeks to receive the PDF copy of your invitation letter by email, and additional time to receive the original letter by post
 - You will receive an email with a link to download a PDF of your official invitation letter after it is approved and processed
 - · Printed invitation letters are mailed by request only
 - SPIE is unable to contact embassies or consulates on behalf of or in support of any individual making arrangements to attend an SPIE event
